- All athletes, coaches, officials, volunteers and staff are required to complete a daily self-declaration prior to arriving at the venue. [here](#)
- All participants must show their proof of vaccine QR code.

#### **Competition Office:**

- Bibs will be distributed by coaches at the beginning of the season.

#### **Lift Tickets:**

- \*NEW 2021\* Lift tickets are required to be purchased ahead of time online, purchase of lift tickets at the venue will not be available. Lift tickets are required to be worn by anyone on the venue property

- \*NEW 2022\* Coaches meeting will be held virtually, the day prior to the event.

- One coach per team is required to be present

**Eligibility:**

- Athletes must have purchased their Compete Membership and [2022 Volunteer bond](#) prior to registering for the competition. If an athlete is in a FIS category, a valid FIS license is also required.
- \*NEW 2022\* all athletes are required to complete the COVID-19 self-declaration form prior to arrival at the venue each day. This will be emailed out each morning.

**Helmet Policy**

- Athletes competing in the event must be wearing a properly fitting, non-damaged certified helmet to be in the field of play. Helmet must meet or exceed EN 1077 (class B) certification or ASTM 2040 certification
