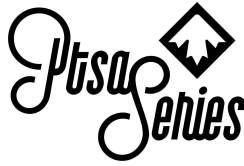

- All athletes, coaches, officials, volunteers and staff are required to complete a daily self-declaration prior to arriving at the venue.
- All participants must show their proof of vaccine QR code.
- All athletes, coaches, officials, volunteers and staff are required to wear their designated bib at all times when at the host venue. It must be fully visible.
- All athletes, coaches, officials, volunteers and staff are required to wear a mask or face covering at all times when at the host venue.
- No spectators will be permitted (foot traffic or ski/snowboard)

Competition Office:

- *NEW 2022* Access to the competition office will be restricted to Ontario Snowboard Staff only. We will be located in The Keg Tent at the top of the hill.
- Bibs will be distributed by coaches at the beginning of the season.

Lift Tickets:

- *NEW 2022* Athlete Lift tickets are required to be purchased ahead of time online, purchase of lift tickets at the venue will not be available. Lift tickets are required to be worn by anyone on the venue property



Categories:

- U11, U13, U15, U15 REC, 15+NON-FIS, 15+FIS
- New to this event is the U15 REC category. Designed to introduce new athletes using soft boots and boards.

Coaches Meeting:

- *NEW 2022* Coaches meeting will be held virtually, the night prior to the event.
- Coaches registered for the event will be notified via email with meeting details
- One coach per team is required to be present

Eligibility:

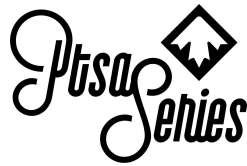
- Athletes must have purchased their Compete Membership and [2022 Volunteer bond](#) prior to registering for the competition. If an athlete is in a FIS category, a valid FIS license is also required. U15 REC category only requires a limited membership for the 2021/2022 season.
- Please note that all competitors must be a member of a sanctioned club and be training with a Canada Snowboard Coaching Program Licensed Coach <https://www.canadasnowboard.ca/en/programs/technical/coaching/>
- Athletes that were unable to compete in a provincial series event for this discipline are required to provide coach recommendation, coaches can complete this via email to janetrichter@ontariosnowboard.ca

Helmet Policy

- Athletes competing in the event must be wearing a properly fitting, non-damaged certified helmet to be in the field of play. Helmet must meet or exceed EN 1077 (class B) certification or ASTM 2040 certification
