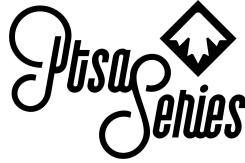

- All athletes, coaches, officials, volunteers and staff are required to complete a daily self-declaration prior to arriving at the venue.
- All participants must show their proof of vaccine QR code.
- All athletes, coaches, officials, volunteers and staff are required to wear their designated bib at all times when at the host venue. It must be fully visible.
- All athletes, coaches, officials, volunteers and staff are required to wear a mask or face covering at all times when at the host venue.
- No spectators will be permitted (foot traffic or ski/snowboard)

**Competition Office:**

- \*NEW 2022\* Access to the competition office will be restricted to Ontario Snowboard Staff only. Competition office will be located in the Keg Tent at the top of the hill.
- Bibs will be distributed by coaches at the beginning of the season. There will be an athlete area within the Keg Tent.

**Lift Tickets:**

- \*NEW 2022\* Lift tickets are required to be purchased ahead of time online, purchase of lift tickets at the venue will not be available.

#### Eligibility:

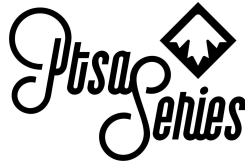
- Athletes must have purchased their Compete Membership and [2022 Volunteer bond](#) prior to registering for the competition. If an athlete is in a FIS category, a valid FIS license is also required.
- Please note that all competitors must be a member of a sanctioned club and be training with a Canada Snowboard Coaching Program Licensed Coach <https://www.canadasnowboard.ca/en/programs/technical/coaching/>
- Athletes that were unable to compete in a provincial series event for this discipline are required to provide coach recommendation, coaches can complete this via email to [janetrichter@ontariosnowboard.ca](mailto:janetrichter@ontariosnowboard.ca)
- Athletes must have completed training on the mandatory training day, unless otherwise approved. For exceptions please email [events@ontariosnowboard.ca](mailto:events@ontariosnowboard.ca).

#### Helmet Policy
