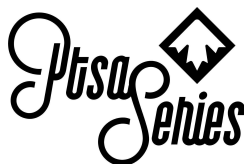

- All athletes, coaches, officials, volunteers and staff are required to complete a daily self-declaration prior to arriving at the venue.
- All participants must show their proof of vaccine QR code.
- All athletes, coaches, officials, volunteers and staff are required to wear their designated bib at all times when at the host venue. It must be fully visible.
- All athletes, coaches, officials, volunteers and staff are required to wear a mask or face covering at all times when at the host venue.
- No spectators will be permitted (foot traffic or ski/snowboard)

Competition Office:

- *NEW 2022* Access to the competition office will be restricted to Ontario Snowboard Staff only. We will be located in the Keg Tent at the top of the hill.
- Bibs will be distributed by coaches at the beginning of the season.

Lift Tickets:

- *NEW 2022* Lift tickets are required to be purchased ahead of time online, purchase of lift tickets at the venue will not be available.

- Freestyle: GROM, 13+ NON-FIS, 13+FIS

Coaches Meeting:

- *NEW 2022* Coaches meeting will be held virtually, the night prior to the event.
- Coaches registered for the event will be notified via email with meeting details
- One coach per team is required to be present

Eligibility:

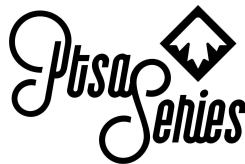
- Please note that all competitors must be a member of a sanctioned club and be training with a Canada Snowboard Coaching Program Licensed Coach <https://www.canadasnowboard.ca/en/programs/technical/coaching/>
- Athletes that were unable to compete in a provincial series event for this discipline are required to provide coach recommendation, coaches can complete this via email to janetrichter@ontariosnowboard.ca
- *NEW 2022* all athletes are required to complete the COVID-19 self-declaration form prior to arrival at the venue each day. This will be emailed out each morning.

Helmet Policy

- Athletes competing in the event must be wearing a properly fitting, non-damaged certified helmet to be in the field of play. Helmet must meet or exceed EN 1077 (class B) certification or ASTM 2040 certification
