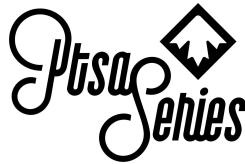

- All athletes, coaches, officials, volunteers and staff are required to complete a daily self-declaration prior to arriving at the venue.
- All participants must show their proof of vaccine QR code.
- All athletes, coaches, officials, volunteers and staff are required to wear their designated bib at all times when at the host venue. It must be fully visible.
- All athletes, coaches, officials, volunteers and staff are required to wear a mask or face covering at all times when at the host venue.
- No spectators will be permitted (foot traffic or ski/snowboard)

Competition Office:

- ***NEW 2022*** Access to the competition office will be restricted to Ontario Snowboard Staff only. We will be located in a Red and Black tent outside with Ontario Snowboard Flags. Location TBD.
- Bibs will be distributed to coaches at the first event. The same bib will be provided for the full season.

Lift Tickets:

- ***NEW 2021*** Lift tickets are required to be purchased ahead of time online, purchase of lift tickets at the venue will not be available. Lift tickets are required to be worn by



anyone on the venue property. Lift Tickets can be purchased through the SnowReg registration

Coaches Meeting:

- *NEW 2022* Coaches meeting will be held virtually, the night prior to the event.
- Coaches registered for the event will be notified via email with meeting details
- One coach per team is required to be present

Helmet Policy

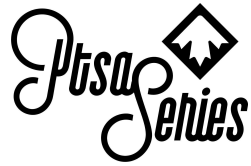
